**Session 1:**

Much like breathing, worship is cyclical. We inhale the fullness of God - His truth, the love He has for us, the freedom found in pursuing Him - and then we exhale praise for God. This taking in and pouring out is the overflow of regular communion with Jesus. Charlie explores why fellowship with the Father is so critical throughout the course of this model.
